# **Eligibility**

This program serves seniors over the age of 60 and individuals with disabilities. In order to qualify for the program, you must complete an application and provide ID verification of age, or signed documentation from a licensed professional regarding your disability diagnosis.

### **How it works**

Once enrolled, you will receive a card, similar to a bank or credit card, that you can use to pay for rides with participating transportation providers. Each month, your card will be loaded with a set amount of funds (usually \$100) and you can decide how much of these funds to spend on what rides.
